ORDER

WHEREAS the appeal of National B.Ed. College Shahdol, Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh dated 14/10/2009 is against the Order No. WRC/APW03291/223451/124th/2009/59907 dated 27/08/2009 of the Western Regional Committee, withdrawing recognition for conducting B.ED. course on the grounds "1) The building photographs attached with the reply do not match with the approved building plan submitted with the application. 2) Building certificate given by Sarpanch does not indicate the location of the building. 3) Laboratory equipments and library books bills are of the dates after inspection by the Visiting team".

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, National B.Ed. College Shahdol (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 14/10/2009 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Shri. S.S. Tiwari, Chairman, National B.Ed. College Shahdol, Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh presented the case of the appellant institution on 01-12-09. In the appeal and during personal presentation requested for allowing the appeal.

AND WHEREAS the Council noted that the institution did not furnish para-wise reply in respect of grounds on which the recognition of the institution was withdrawn. The Council also noted that the report of the inspection conducted by the VT u/s 17 of the NCTE Act on 4-5-09 was negative and it inter-alia, indicated that the society was having 1.260 Hect. of land on which a building fit for commercial use to run an agency was developed; it was in this building the B.Ed. college was being run; the building was not suitable for B.Ed. college; all NCTE norms with regard to building infrastructure were flouted; the instructional and infrastructural facilities like library facility, science, ET and psychology lab etc. were also inadequate, the building was not constructed as per NCTE norms. Thus, Land site map given was not of the building inspected. The Council was, therefore, of the view that there was no ground for accepting the appeal and hence it should be rejected.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was no ground to accept the appeal and hence it should be rejected. Accordingly, the appeal was rejected and WRC's order dated 27-08-09 was confirmed.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby confirms the Order appealed against.

ORDER

WHEREAS The appeal of Department of Continuing Education & Extension Programme (Barkatullah University), Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh dated 06/10/2009 is against the Order No. No. WRC/APW001845/223358/123rd/2009/59863 dated 26/08/2009 of the Western Regional Committee, withdrawal recognition for conducting B. Ed course on the grounds that Non compliance of show cause notice/clarification within stipulated time.

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Department of Continuing Education & Extension Programme (Barkatullah University) (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 08/10/2009 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Dr. Neerja Sharma, Prof. & Dean Education, Department of Continuing Education & Extension Programme (Barkatullah University), Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh presented the case of the appellant institution on 01-12-09. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that the university had appointed regular staff as per the provisions of the the university and non teaching staff had also been appointed for B. Ed course on full time basis. It was also submitted that the total number of books relating to education available was 3906. It was further submitted that on the basis of inspection report conducted under section 13 of the NCTE Act, NCTE Hqrs placed the name of the institution under the list of on institutions which were fit to under take the examination for the session 2007-08.

AND WHEREAS the Council noted that WRC conducted inspection under section 17 of the NCTE Act on 23.09.08 and on the basis of this report, WRC withdrew the recognition of the institution only on 26.08.09 i.e. almost after a year. Meanwhile and prior to issue of this order by the WRC, NCTE Hqrs reviewed the recognition status of the appellant institution, after conducting an inspection under section 13 of the NCTE Act on 08.12.08, in compliance to the direction of the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur vide order dt. 01.12.08. NCTE submitted a detailed report to the court about this case mentioning clearly that the institution gives a satisfactory picture and may continue as a recognised institution. As such, the Council felt that WRC was not justified in considering the matter there after and withdrawing the recognition, without taking into account the interim development, wherein the Council in a separate action and after due consideration of the inspection report has treated this institution as a recognized institution. In view of the above the Council came to the conclusion that there was adequate justification in accepting the appeal.

AND WHEREAS After perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT report and after considering oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and reverse WRC's order dated 26-08-09 with direction to the WRC to restore the recognition of the institution, immediately.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby reverses the Order appealed against.

ORDER

WHEREAS the appeal of Shri Shivdan Singh Smriti College, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh dated 24/09/2009 is against the Order No. F. NRC/NCTE/F-7/UP-1835/141st Meeting/2009/6861 dated 24/07/2009 of the Northern Regional Committee, refusing recognition for conducting M.Ed course on the grounds "The list of appointed Faculty as per NCTE norms has not been submitted till date".

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, Shri Shivdan Singh Smriti College (hereinafter referred to as the appellant), preferred an appeal dated 24/09/2009 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS Shri. Ashok Pachauri, Lecturer, Shri Shivdan Singh Smriti College, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh presented the case of the appellant institution on 30-11-09. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that qualified faculty members were appointed by duly constituted Selection Committee; affidavits of staff relating to experience and affidavit of management were sent to the NRC with their letter dated 1.10.2007 and in response to the NRC's letter dated 5.2.2008, the same information was communicated again with their letter dated 29.6.2009.

AND WHEREAS the Council noticed that the institution's letter dated 1.10.2007 has been received in the NRC office. The other letter dated 29.6.2009 is enclosed to the appeal bears the NRC stamp dated 1.7.2009. The committee therefore came to the conclusion that the appeal deserves to be accepted and the case to be remanded to NRC to examine the staff details enclosed to the institution's letter dt. 29.06.09 and take further necessary action.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT Report and after hearing oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal, set aside NRC's order dated 24-07-09 and remand back the case to NRC to examine the staff details enclosed to the institution's letter dt. 29.06.09 and take further necessary action.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Shri Shivdan Singh Smriti College, Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh to the NRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.
